1. Birth and Death (23)

For every **100 girl babies** who died in the first 27 days of life in 2018 **127.5 boy babies died**.

For every **100 girl babies** who died after the first 27 days but in the first year of life in 2018 **130 boy babies die**.

For every **100 infant girls** who died under one year in 2021, **116 infant boys died**.

For every **100 girls ages 1 to 4 years** who died in 2021, **118 boys died**.

For every **100 girls ages 5 to 14 years** who died in 2021, **134 boys died**.

For every **100 girls and women ages 15 to 24 years** who died in 2021, **257 boys and men died**.

For every **100 women ages 25 to 34 years** who died in 2021 **231 men died**.

For every **100 women ages 35 to 44 years** who died in 2021 **186 men died**.
